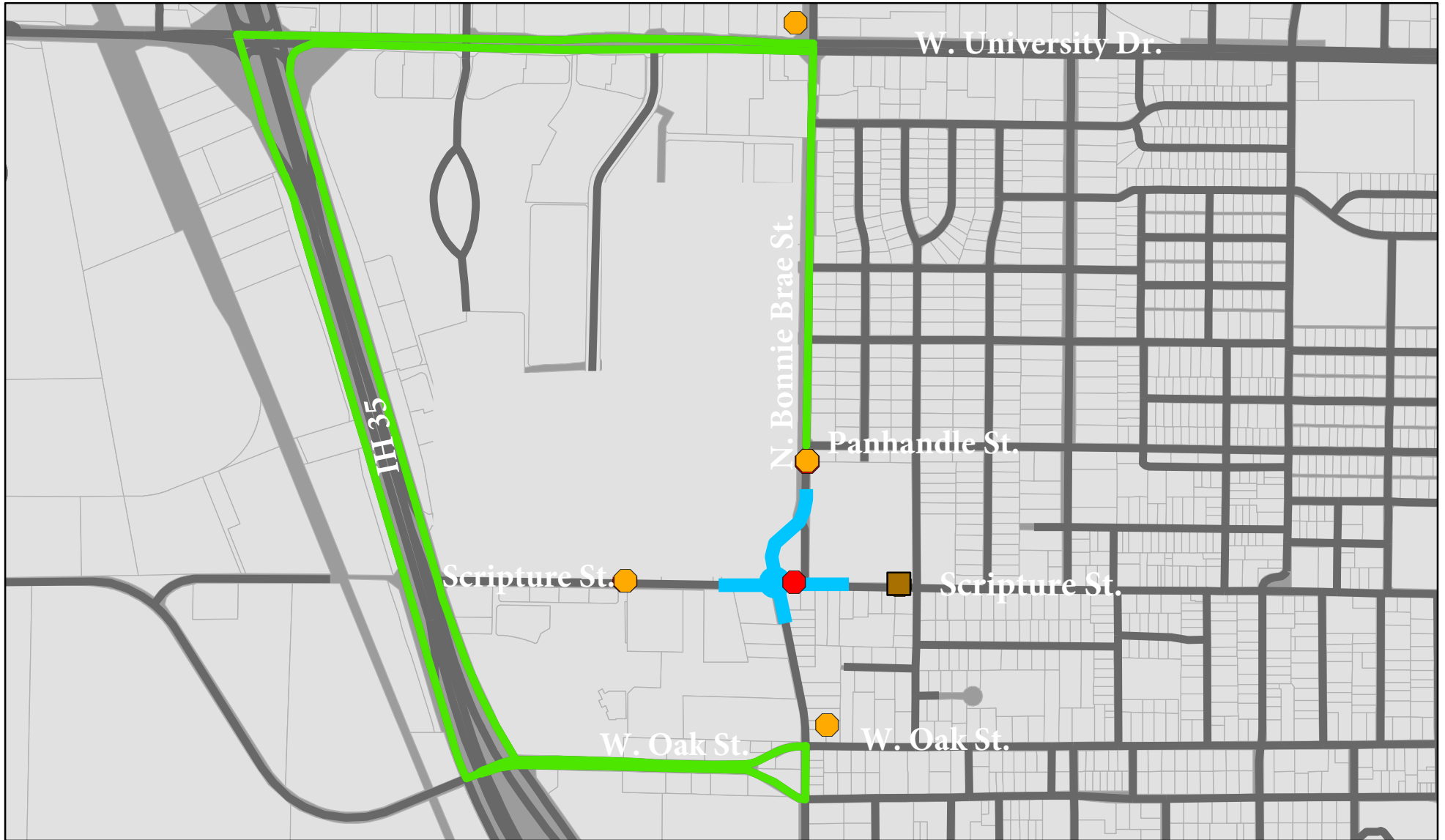




Bonnie Brae St / Scripture St Detour Map

PROJECT FACT SHEET UPDATE

Scope: Install a roundabout at the intersection of Bonnie Brae Street and Scripture Street as part of the overall Bonnie Brae IH 35 to Scripture road project that was a part of the 2014 City Bond Program. Also included are associated drainage improvements and water and wastewater relocations. The work zone will extend slightly beyond the intersection along Bonnie Brae (north and south), and along Scripture (east and west). During construction, the intersection will be fully closed, as necessitated by the significant lowering of the road.

Construction Budget: \$3.4M
