Please call 911 for an ambulance or go to the nearest emergency department if your child:

- · is unresponsive or unconscious
- · was involved in a car accident
- · has visible bones or bleeding that will not stop

CI	Mild allergic reactions
+	Severe allergic reactions (trouble breathing)
CI	Asthma attack (mild wheezing)
+	Asthma attack (wheezing/trouble breathing)
(!	Bites/stings
+	Broken bone (visible, obvious deformity)
. !	Broken bone
(!	Burn (minor)
+	Burn (serious, including eyes, electrical or acid burns, infection or blister)
+	Cast-related problems (after hours)
(!	Cold/cough
. !	Cut (minor)
+	Cut (bleeding that won't stop)
+	Dehydration
(!	Diarrhea
(!	Earache/ear infection
+	Fainting due to exercise or activity

C!	Fever (child is older than 2 months and has no other medical problems)
+	Fever (child is younger than 2 months)
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C !	Head injury (no loss of consciousness or other concerns)
+	Head injury (loss of consciousness, confusion, vomiting)
C!	Laryngitis
(!	Migraine headache
C!	Nosebleed (not resulting from an injury to the face/nose)
(!	Pink eye
